PICKING:**

**TWO SONGS OF CHOICE ONE FAST AND ONE SLOW. TOTAL FOUR MINUTE PLAYING TIME
ONE SONG OF CHOICE FOR TIE BREAKER**

TWIN *FIDDLE ADDITIONAL RULES:

**BOTH CONTESTANTS MUST ENTER SINGLE FIDDLE CONTEST, ONLY ONE TUNE WILL BE PLAYED.
NO TUNE MAY BE REPEATED BY EITHER PLAYER FROM THE SINGLE FIDDLE CONTEST.
